



2017 Championship Points System

International GT will award points at each event culminating with year-end champions and two runners up in Stuttgart Cup Cayman, Mission Foods GT3 Cup and Maranello Cup. Award winners must have entered and participated in a minimum of 4 total events.

Starting Points	Five points will be awarded for entering, starting and completing one race lap.
Position Points	Points will be allocated for finishing position as follows: 1 st = 10, 2 nd = 8, 3 rd = 6, 4 th = 4, 5 th = 3, 6 th = 2, 7 th = 1. 50% of class winners' laps must be completed to receive position points.
Finishing Points	Ten finishing points will be awarded for completing 50% of the overall winners' laps.
Competition Points	Half (.5) of a point will be awarded to the top five finishing positions for every car in their respective class that each competitor finishes ahead of. Maximum bonus points are as follows: 1 st = 2.5, 2 nd = 2, 3 rd = 1.5, 4 th = 1, 5 th = .5
Livery Bonus Points	3 year-end bonus points for Stuttgart Cup cars registering and running "historic" Porsche livery.
Exhibition Points	Participants in this class is not eligible for championship points or race podium awards.

- Championship award is made to the driver of record
- Drivers can change cars or co-drive within the season and accumulate points as long as it is in the same class.

Tie breakers:

1. Most class wins
2. Best average finishing position of all races entered.
3. Most events entered

 2. Pirelli – 4 corners or wheel wells
 3. B.R.M. – front fenders
